SBA Deadline Approaching for Working Capital Loans in Georgia for Secretary of Agriculture Disaster Declaration for March Freeze, Frost, Ice and High Winds [1]

On 22 Dec, 2022

The attached SBA press release [2] and Georgia fact sheet [3] were issued today.

The <u>U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA)</u> [4] is reminding small businesses, small agricultural cooperatives, small businesses engaged in aquaculture, and most private nonprofit organizations that **Jan. 23** is the filing deadline for federal working capital loans in **Georgia** due to freeze, frost, ice and high winds that occurred March 11-14, 2022.

Low-interest disaster loans are available in the **Georgia** counties of Appling, Bryan, Bulloch, Candler, Emanuel, Evans, Liberty, Long, Tattnall, Toombs and Wayne.

Under this declaration, the SBA's <u>Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL)</u> [5] program is available to eligible farm-related and nonfarm-related entities that suffered financial losses as a direct result of this disaster. Apart from aquaculture enterprises, SBA cannot provide disaster loans to agricultural producers, farmers and ranchers.

The loan amount can be up to \$2 million with interest rates of **2.94** percent for small businesses and **1.875** percent for private nonprofit organizations, with terms up to 30 years.

Applicants may apply online using the Electronic Loan Application (ELA) via the SBA's secure website at DisasterLoanAssistance.sba.gov [6]/ela/s/ and should apply under SBA declaration # 17467
