On Saturday, enter the RazorBack Mud Run, an adventure race thru the woods, swamp and mud and a series of natural and man-made obstacles. Come to Partin Park and watch the professionals compete in 4 competition categories: pork shoulder, pork ribs, beef brisket and chicken. Other activities include a classic car show, chainsaw carving competition, kid's creative play area, arts and crafts, live music and an Indian artifacts show with an archeologist on site to date your treasures.
